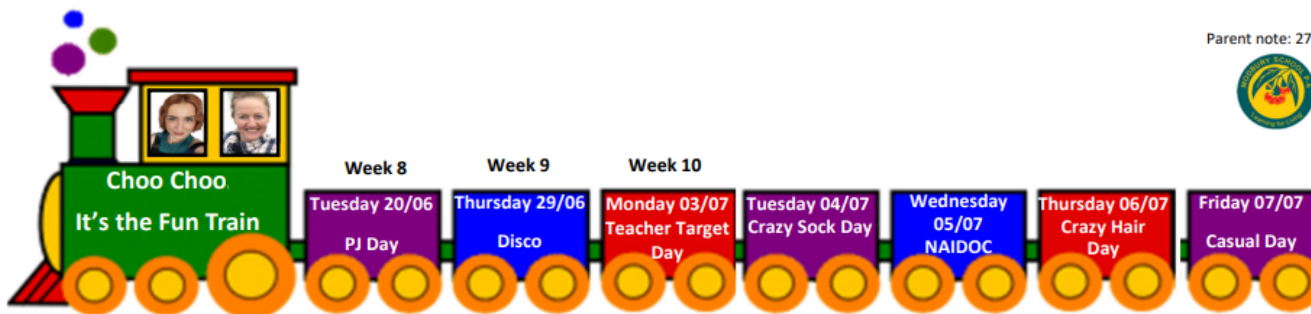

- Wednesday 05 July - NAIDOC Celebrations

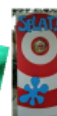
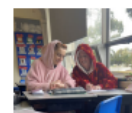
