
Congratulations Joseph!




I really enjoyed doing creek walk because I get to talk to my friends and helped me get started with my learning.


I enjoyed the creek walk because I got to talk to my friends and run around and have some fun. The least best thing about creek walk is that we don't do 2 or 3 laps around the creek
