


Sports Day - A huge thank you to Isaac and the Sports Day

Spring is Here!

Snake season in Australia is from September to April.

- Leave it alone. Snakes are generally shy and will not attack unless provoked.
- Stand still. Snakes can't hear but can sense vibrations, if you stand still they are less likely to know you are there.
- Wear closed shoes.
- Long pants are recommended when walking through bush.


