

Modbury School has beautiful vegetation inside the school and in the surrounding creek and parklands. Please talk to your children about becoming aware of snakes.

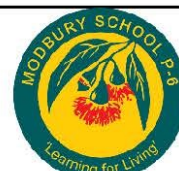
If you see a snake:

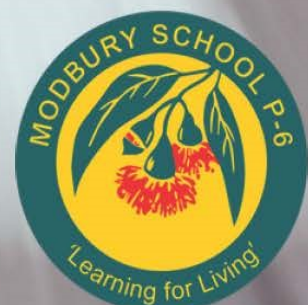

Thank you to all our parents that joined us on the day and supported this event - We love seeing you at our school!

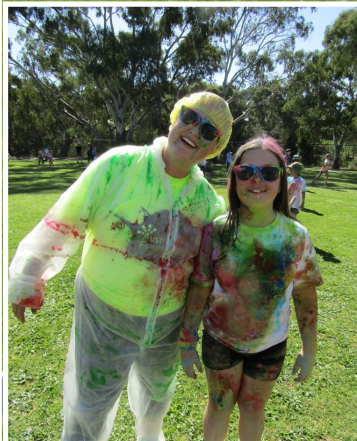
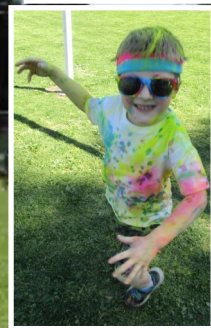
